Sponsors Corner Frequently asked questions.

Q. Is the sponsor responsible for paying for the pilgrim to attend the walk?

A. No, that is a personal preference of the sponsor.

Q. Is the sponsor required to attend all of the 4th day events while the walk is going on?

A. Yes.

Q. As a sponsor, who should I be praying about to sponsor?

A. The sponsor's first responsibility is to spend concentrated time in **prayer** in an effort **to discern** whom God wants you to sponsor.
